






History of Viewing Time Assessments
First used by Rozenzweig, 1942
Used by many researchers to assess sexual interest since then.
First commercial use was a proprietary scoring and data interpretation system marketed by Abel Screening, Inc., 1996
Several standardized systems available: Affinity, Limestone, LOOK










- Each test is an experiment
- Finds baseline information for that individual
- Ipsative scores are frequently misinterpreted as norm-referenced.
- "Deviant" and "abnormal" assume that the scores are referenced to "normal"






Based on early LOOK research, we found (unpublished) approximately 30% of non-offending people show sexual interests in children.


