Central Eight risk factors associated with general and violent recidivism (Bonta & Andrews, 2024)

- History of antisocial behavior
 - Antisocial personality pattern
 - Antisocial cognition and attitudes
 - Antisocial associates and limited association with prosocial companions
 - Poor family and/or marital relationships
 - Low performance in school and/or work
 - Involvement in criminal or disorganized leisure or recreation activities
 - Problems with substance abuse
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Psychologically meaningful risk factors (Mann et al., 2010)

- Sexual preoccupation
 - Sexual deviancy
 - Offence supportive attitudes
 - Emotional congruence with children
 - Lack of emotional intimacy with adults
 - Lifestyle impulsiveness
 - Poor problem solving
 - Resistance to rules/supervision
 - Negative social influences
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General and specific responsivity checklist

For program adherence audit or assessment of client needs (adapted from Jung, 2017)

General responsivity

- Cognitive-behavioral in orientation
- Highly structured, specify aims and tasks
- Manual based
- Delivered in the intended manner by program developers
- Housed within institutions with personnel committed to the ideals of rehabilitation
- Trained, qualified, appropriately supervised staff

Specific responsivity

- Poor treatment motivation / stages of change
 - Denial or problematic minimization
 - Developmental delay
 - Learning disability
 - Personality patterns: Psychopathy Borderline Other, specify: _____
 - Culture-specific concerns
 - Gender identity
 - Sexuality
 - Mental health instability
 - Adverse childhood experiences
 - Active substance abuse or dependency
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
